Alan M. Jones OD, PA, of Vision Rehabilitation Services of Florida, Inc., checks every patient for dry eye disease. If dry eye is detected, his treatment protocol always begins with a standard dry eye therapy — artificial tears. "Some patients can't use just any drop because they are allergic to the preservatives in standard over-the-counter drops," says Dr. Jones. To avoid an allergic reaction or unpleasant sensation caused by preservatives, he prescribes OASIS TEARS®, which are formulated to provide instant relief and lasting comfort without preservatives.

Gary V. Hathcoat, OD, of Precision EyeCare Optometry in Mt Washington, Ky., takes a similar approach. Dr. Hathcoat prescribes preservativefree OASIS TEARS® to all of his patients as part of a daily lid hygiene regimen that involves morning warm soaks and lid scrubs, and twice-daily use of OASIS TEARS®.

A TEST RUN

For patients with mild to moderate dry eye disease, treatment with OASIS TEARS® alone may relieve symptoms. However, for more severe cases, additional treatment may be necessary. "Once you start to get into the moderate to severe dry eye

disease, OASIS TEARS® in conjunction with punctal occlusion is often the way to go," explains Dr. Jones.

To determine whether a permanent silicone punctal plug is a good treatment option for his dry eye patients, Dr. Jones uses SOFT PLUG® Collagen Punctal Plug by OASIS® Medical as a pretest for 7 to 10 days in the lower lids. Patients monitor the progress themselves, comparing their response to the SOFT PLUG® Collagen Plugs plus OASIS® TEARS versus the drops alone. "Some of my patients don't like it the first time I insert the SOFT PLUG® Collagen Plugs. They say their eyes tear too much, or that there wasn't any difference between the dry eye therapy with the OASIS® TEARS alone and the collagen plugs."

For those patients with positive responses to the collagen plug pretest, Dr. Jones proceeds with silicone plugs. He prefers the SOFT PLUG® Silicone Punctal Plugs by OASIS® Medical, not only because they are easy to insert, but also because they can be removed just as easily with no damage to the eye.

"I find both SOFT PLUG" Silicone Punctal Plugs and SOFT PLUG® Collagen Plugs easy to size and insert," says Dr. Jones. "Of most importance, if the plugs aren't working and the patient wants them taken out, I can reverse the procedure with ease. It's one of the few surgical procedures that can be reversed without any damage to the eye. And patients really like that."

Although many patients have success with silicone plugs, there are some who experience sensitivities or allergic reactions to the material. The hydrogel material in the FORM FIT® Hydrogel Plug is safe and biocompatible, which addresses silicone allergies and sensitivities across a diverse patient base. "When you insert the plug into the punctum, it's like a freeform occlusion that takes on water and expands and just fills the canal, so it goes in and expands with the tear," says Dr. Hathcoat.
